A copy of the Contractor and/or each subcontractor's license, proof of insurance and contact name, must be secured and provided to the Landscape Committee prior to work beginning and included with this application. (Home improvement center, i.e. Lowe's or Home Depot, use subcontractors for installation)
- 4. It is each unit owner's responsibility to submit this form in accordance with the requirements and restrictions outlined in the Oakley Green governing documents. Alterations or improvements require prior written approval by the Board. All work shall be confined within the Limited Common Elements,
- 5. No Work may not begin until you receive written approval from Property Manager FirstService. All work must be completed within 90 days of approval or project approval may be withdrawn.
- 6. IRRIGATION MODIFICATIONS: Are the sole financial responsibility of the Unit Owner and will be made at the Unit Owner's expense **unless indicated otherwise**. Any related irrigation costs billed by the Master Association, shall be paid by the Unit Owner before any work is started. Irrigation modifications shall be made **ONLY** by the Master Association's Irrigation Contractor. Only the irrigation vendor under contract with The Master Association is authorized to move or cap irrigation lines or sprinklers. Irrigation lines shall be moved prior to start of Landscape work. Unit owners may not install their own irrigation/watering system/lines using potable water.
- 7. Any unauthorized irrigation changes will be subject to a fine from the Master Association. The Master Association will inspect unauthorized projects for damage and will make necessary repairs which will be made by the Master Association's Irrigation Vendor and billed to the Unit Owner.
- 8. It is the Unit Owner's responsibility to notify the Board of Directors through the Landscape Review Committee using the attached form, "Notice Of Completion Form" when work is completed.

OWNER RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. All Landscaping modifications are the sole financial and maintenance responsibility of the Unit Owner including without any limitations pruning, feeding, weeding, and replacement if and as needed.
- 2. If planting(s) are in a resident created bed, the weeding and mulching plus the care of the bed is the Unit Owner's responsibility. If plantings are not properly maintained, a letter of violation will be mailed to the Unit Owner. If the problem is not taken care of within 5 days of the letters date, as the Unit Owner, I/we agree that the Association will be given the authority to remedy the problem and, as the Unit Owner I/we agree to pay for the services rendered. Removal of a modification may be requested by the Board should the modification become a nuisance and, as the Unit Owner, I/we agree that removal will be at my expense.
- 3. If the unit is sold, as the Unit Owner, I/we agree to inform the new unit owners of their responsibility to maintain these plantings or will return the area to its original design and plantings at our sole expense.
